# **COLOUR**

Dark purple, black hues.

#### **NOSE**

Dark berry fruit with hints of peppery spice.

#### **PALATE**

Soft upfront notes of plums and blackcurrants with integrated oak structure. The finish is soft with elegance and depth.

### **WINEMAKING**

Selected from 25-70 year old vines in subregions on Ebenezer, Kalimna, Stonewell, Vine Vale and Lights Pass. Open fermented for 5-8 days.

# **VINTAGE REPORT**

High quality from very low yields with some vineyards over 50% down with rainfall significantly well below average. Wines are deeply coloured with excellent structure and fruit development. Wine will have longevity.
