COLOUR

Light plum colour

NOSE

Lifted perfumed characters of plum, cassis and red berries and a hint of spice.

PALATE

Soft and smooth on the palate with berry characters intermingled with touch of spicy oak. The finish is smooth and persistent.

WINEMAKING

Open Fermented for 7 days with some parcels having extended skin contact. Basket pressed and matured in older oak. Blended to enhance lift, structure and spice.

VINTAGE REPORT

Winter rainfalls and lighter spring rain coupled with an Indian summer created near perfect growing conditions albeit a little dry. Yields were slightly above average delivering good fruit flavours and healthy grapes.
