



Single Vineyard 2018 Limb Cabernet Sauvignon

COLOUR

Deep, dark purple.

NOSE

Cassis and spice dominate palate with touch of savoury oak

PALATE

Cassis/blackcurrant dominate the palate with integrated natural tannins and a long, persistent finish.

WINEMAKING

Taken from vines planted in 1980 in Seppeltsfield. Open fermented and basket pressed and aged in combination new and second use French oak.

VINTAGE REPORT

Excellent winter rainfalls and lighter spring rain coupled with an Indian summer created near perfect growing conditions albeit a little dry. Yields were slightly above average delivering good fruit flavours and healthy grapes.
