



Single Vineyard 2018 Hoffmann Shiraz

COLOUR

Deep, dark red.

NOSE

Deep and brooding with concentrated fruit characters.

PALATE

Richly structured with dark fruit characters, subliminally integrated oak and depth of flavour.

WINEMAKING

Sourced from the Hoffmann vineyard planted between 1888-1912. Hand plunged for 9 days then basket pressed into new and older French oak.

VINTAGE REPORT

Excellent winter rainfalls and lighter spring rain coupled with an Indian summer created near perfect growing conditions albeit a little dry. Yields were slightly above average delivering good fruit flavours and healthy grapes.
